



## UNIFORM POLICY

The Findon High School uniform has been endorsed by the Governing Council in accordance with regulations for its development and approval. The approved supplier is Hambours, 2 Wilson Street, Royal Park, SA.

Our Governing Council has given **three main reasons for this policy** and the strong support it enjoys.

- The wearing of a neat and tidy uniform is widely regarded as a positive indication of a successful school, and one in which the parents and students have real pride and a sense of ownership.
- The use of uniform is a cheaper alternative than wearing casual clothes. Our school's uniform committee of students, staff and parents ensures that our uniform items are reasonably priced.
- To ensure students' safety it is helpful for staff on duty to have all our students easily identifiable.

### UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS YEARS 8-12

**Students are expected to wear correct school uniform at all times, including excursions and to and from school**

Shirts	White short or long sleeved with logo (Tie optional)
Pants	Charcoal Pants – <b>Denim, cargo or track pants are not acceptable</b>
Shorts	Charcoal Shorts
Dress	Checked – <b>Please note the prescribed length of the dress is no shorter than the top of the knee</b>
Skirt	Tartan – <b>Please note the prescribed length of the skirt is no shorter than the top of the knee</b>
Jumper	Charcoal Wool blend V Neck with logo
Spray Jacket	Maroon with logo
Soft Shell Jacket	Grey with logo
Tie	Maroon and white Findon tie
Blazer	Maroon with logo – Made to order
Socks	Plain short white, black, grey or knee high white
Shoes	Plain black leather/leather-look enclosed shoes or T-bar sandals
Tights	Plain black, grey or neutral with foot – <b>Not to be worn with socks</b>
House Top	Polo shirt in house colours with house logo – <b>Not to be worn at formal occasions (eg assemblies, excursions or Principal Tours)</b>

### ACCESSORIES

Back Pack	Black with logo
Baseball Cap	Grey with FHS emblem - <b>not to be worn inside the classroom</b>
Beanie	Grey with FHS emblem - <b>not to be worn inside the classroom</b>

### ADDITIONAL UNIFORM OPTIONS FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS (Yr12)

The Graduate 2 students (Yr 12) are permitted to wear a special jacket as determined by the Graduate Coordinator on an annual basis.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

**Physical Education and Sport:** To encourage good personal hygiene habits we believe that our students **must change clothes** for Physical Education lessons. Students are expected to bring a change of clothes. On most occasions the school will supply appropriate uniforms for sporting teams who compete in our sports programs. Students may still need to provide their own shorts.

**Jewellery,** including facial piercing, is not encouraged but may be worn only if it is relatively inconspicuous and does not constitute a safety hazard.

**Hair Colour** – any hair dyed an unnatural colour is not acceptable



## ANSWERS TO FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT OUR UNIFORM

- Students are expected to wear full school uniform to and from school. (Including House Polo)
- Students are expected to wear the school uniform on ALL school days throughout the year.
- Students are expected to wear full school uniform on excursions. On some excursions the use of school uniform may be inappropriate. On such occasions parents and students will be informed on the consent form.
- Leggings not permitted.
- Pants are to be school trousers, not denim, cord or cargo pants. Track pants or pants with elastic on ankles are not acceptable.
- Jewellery, including facial piercing, is not encouraged but may be worn only if it is relatively inconspicuous and does not constitute a safety hazard. No jewellery to be worn in Tech Studies. Hair must be tied back in Home Ec and Tech Studies
- Students are encouraged to wear hats outside in Terms 1 & 4. Hats are not to be worn inside corridors or classrooms.
